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## GLOSSARY

### Population by Ethnicity

The 2001 Census used 16 categories of ethnic group, which were then grouped into five broad categories. The more recent 2011 Census used 18 categories of ethnic group but which are also grouped into five broad categories. The two new categories are 'Gypsy or Irish Traveller' and 'Arab'.

### Length of Residence in the UK

The length of residence in the UK is derived from the date that a person last arrived to live in the UK. Short visits away from the UK are not counted in determining the date that a person last arrived. Length of residence is only applicable to usual residents who were not born in the UK. It does not include usual residents born in the UK who have emigrated and since returned - these are recorded in the category 'Born in the UK'.

### Marital and Civil Partnership Status

Marital and civil partnership status classifies an individual according to their legal marital or registered same-sex civil partnership status as at census day, 27 March 2011.

### General Health

General health is a self-assessment of a person's general state of health. People were asked to assess whether their health was very good, good, fair, bad or very bad. This assessment is not based on a person's health over any specified period of time.

### Long-term health problem or disability

A long-term health problem or disability that limits a person's day-to-day activities, and has lasted, or is expected to last, at least 12 months. This includes problems that are related to old age. People were asked to assess whether their daily activities were limited a lot or a little by such a health problem, or whether their daily activities were not limited at all.

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## Provision of unpaid care

A person is a provider of unpaid care if they look after or give help or support to family members, friends, neighbours or others because of long-term physical or mental ill health or disability, or problems related to old age. This does not include any activities as part of paid employment.

No distinction is made about whether any care that a person provides is within their own household or outside of the household, so no explicit link can be made about whether the care provided is for a person within the household who has poor general health or a long-term health problem

## Households - Definition

A household is defined as one person living alone, or a group of people (not necessarily related) living at the same address who share cooking facilities and share a living room or sitting room or dining area

A household must contain at least one person whose place of usual residence is at the address.

A group of short-term residents living together is not classified as a household, and neither is a group of people at an address where only visitors are staying.

## Household spaces - Definition

A household space is the accommodation occupied by an individual household or, if unoccupied, available for an individual household

## Households - Tenure,

Tenure provides information about whether a household rents or owns the accommodation that it occupies and, if rented, combines this with information about the type of landlord who owns or manages the accommodation.

## Household Composition

This table shows the makeup of families in households at the time of the 2011 Census.

A **communal establishment resident** is defined as a person living in managed residential accommodation who has lived, or intends to live there for six months or more. Individual's resident in a communal establishment for less than six months are included at their home address, apart from those with no usual address elsewhere (they are included as residents in the communal establishments)

**Communal establishment other or not stated** includes communal residential accommodation which is not a medical or care establishment e.g. prisons, hostels, religious accommodation, educational accommodation.

## Economic Activity

Economic activity relates to whether or not a person who was aged 16 to 74 was working or looking for work in the week before census.

Rather than a simple indicator of whether or not someone was currently in employment, it provides a measure of whether or not a person was an active participant in the labour market.

A person's economic activity is derived from their 'Activity last week'. This is an indicator of their status or availability for employment - whether employed, actively looking for work, waiting to start a new job, available to start a new job, or their status if not employed or not seeking employment.

Full time students will be classified as Economically Active if they take on part time work. A student who does not take part in any work at all is classified as Economically Inactive.

## Travel to work

Method of travel to work numbers may be higher than the number of people who are in employment.

In 2001, if a respondent recorded that their Workplace Address was "at home", it was assumed that they did not travel for work, and they were also recorded as working at home in the Travel data.

However, in 2011, this assumption has not been made. Therefore, any respondent who works at home, but also travels (e.g. a mobile hairdresser) is recorded as "Working at home" in data or Workplace (which has not yet been published) but as "Driving" (or whichever mode of travel they recorded) in the Travel data.

## Qualifications - 2011 Census

The highest level of qualification is derived from the question asking people to indicate all types of qualifications held. People were also asked if they held foreign qualifications and to indicate the closest equivalent.

**No Qualifications** - No academic or professional qualifications

**Level 1 Qualifications** - 1-4 O Levels/CSE/GCSEs (any grades), Entry Level, Foundation Diploma, NVQ level 1, Foundation GNVQ, Basic/Essential Skills

**Level 2 Qualifications** - 5+ O Level (Passes)/CSEs (Grade 1)/GCSEs (Grades A\*-C), School Certificate, 1 A Level/ 2-3 AS Levels/VCEs, Intermediate/Higher Diploma, Welsh Baccalaureate Intermediate Diploma, NVQ level 2, Intermediate GNVQ, City and Guilds Craft, BTEC First/General Diploma, RSA Diploma

**Level 3 Qualifications** - 2+ A Levels/VCEs, 4+ AS Levels, Higher School Certificate, Progression/Advanced Diploma, Welsh Baccalaureate Advanced Diploma, NVQ Level 3; Advanced GNVQ, City and Guilds Advanced Craft, ONC, OND, BTEC National, RSA Advanced Diploma

**Level 4+ Qualifications** - Degree (for example BA, BSc), Higher Degree (for example MA, PhD, PGCE), NVQ Level 4-5, HNC, HND, RSA Higher Diploma, BTEC Higher level, Foundation degree (NI), Professional qualifications (for example teaching, nursing, accountancy)

**Other** - Vocational/Work-related Qualifications, Foreign Qualifications (Not stated/ level unknown).
